## DEPT. OF HEALTH

### DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

Regulations to amend "Regulations of the Saint John Sub-District Board of Health, additional to the Regulations of the Department of Health regarding Dairies and Milk, under authority of Section 44 of the Public Health Act, 1918".

Section 2 of the Regulations of the Saint John Sub-District Board of Health, additional to the Regulations of the Department of Health, regarding Dairies and Milk is hereby amended by the addition after "milk or cream" of the words "except 'certified' milk or cream as hereinafter defined"; and by the addition to the same section of an additional subsection (b) which shall read as follows:

It shall be unlawful to apply the term "certified" to any milk or cream which does not comply with the following standard:

1. It shall be taken from cows semi-annually subjected to the tuberculin test and found without reaction, such tests to be done by a veterinary surgeon approved of by the Sub-District Board of Health, and at the expense of the owner of such herd.

2. Milk shall not, at any time within thirty hours after milking, contain more than 20,000 bacteria per cubic centimetre from June to September both inclusive; and not at any time within thirty hours after milking more than 10,000 bacteria per cubic centimetre from October to May both inclusive. Cream shall not at any time contain more than 10,000 bacteria per cubic centimetre.

3. It shall be free from blood, pus, sediment or disease producing organisms.

4. It shall be free from disagreeable odor or taste.

5. It shall be cooled to 45 F., or under, within half an hour after milking, and kept at that temperature until delivered to the consumer.

6. It shall reach the consumer within thirty hours after milking.

7. Milk shall contain twelve to thirteen per cent of milk solids of which four per cent is butter fat.

8. It shall be from a farm the herd of which is inspected monthly by a recognized veterinarian and certified by him as free from infection and the employees of which are examined monthly by a regular qualified physician and certified free from the infection of any communicable disease, expenses of such inspection to be borne by the owner of such herd.

9. It shall, immediately after being cooled, be bottled in sterile bottles and shall be immediately sealed, and such seal shall include a sterile hood which completely covers the top of the bottle.

10. It shall be plainly labelled "certified milk" or "certified cream", with the name and address of the dairyman

producing same and the day or date of milking.

11. Provided that no milk or cream shall be sold as "certified" until a certificate setting forth that the above conditions have been complied with, and that the regulations as laid down by the Department of Health of the Province of New Brunswick respecting Dairies and Milk have been complied with, is obtained from time to time from the District Medical Health Officer of the District in which is located the Saint John Milk District.

That regulation No. 7 of the Regulations of the Saint John Sub-District Board of Health, additional to the Regulations of the Department of Health, regarding Dairies and Milk, be amended by the addition of the words "and milk bottles" after the word cans in the first line.

The amended section shall then read: Milk cans and milk bottles must be used exclusively for milk. Any can used for returning skim milk, whey or sour milk from the dairy to the producer must not be used for milk and such can must be painted some distinctive color and plainly marked with the words "Not to be used for milk" the letters of which shall not be less than two inches in height.
