## Letters Patent Granted

### "MARITIME COAL SERVICE LTD."

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916", and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Eighteenth day of March, A. To purchase, build, charter, equip, load on commission, repair and hire steam or other ships, boats and vessels of all kinds and to construct by lease and otherwise acquire railways or other means of transportation to and from any place where any of the Company's operations are carried on and operate the same in connection with its own business upon lands owned or controlled by the Company.

To manufacture, import, export, buy, sell, refine, compound and deal in chemicals, dye-stuffs, cements, super phosphates, fertilizers, coal-tar, coal-tar products and derivatives and all by-products of coal separately or in combination and under all conditions and at all stages of preparation and manufacture.

To purchase or otherwise acquire
