E. L. NEWCOMBE,

Whereas, it hath pleased Almighty God in His Great Goodness to vouchsafe this year unto Our Dominion of Canada, a bountiful harvest and other blessings:—We therefore, considering that these blessings enjoyed by Our people throughout the said Dominion do call for a solemn and public acknowledgment, have
