Letters Patent Granted

"SOUTH BRANCH FISHING CLUB, LIMITED".

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916, and Amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Sixteenth day of April, A. D. 1924, incorporating, Walter C. Allison, Merchant, of Rothesay, in the County of Kings and Province of New Brunswick; Joseph A. Likely, Merchant; and William R. Tennant, Financial Agent; both of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province aforesaid, for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, take over or otherwise acquire the fishing rights and privileges, lands and leases and other properties, rights and privileges now owned, held and occupied by the applicants and others on or near the South Branch of Lake in the County of Charlotte in the Province of New Brunswick, subject to the obligations, if any, affecting the same and to pay for the same in paid-up shares of the Club.

To acquire, own, hold, and dispose of lands and premises and the rights, privileges and easements of fishing, shooting, hunting and boating on any other river lake or waters in the Province of New Brunswick for the mutual pleasure of its members and their friends, and to hold all licenses and leases necessary for that purpose.

To purchase, acquire, own, erect and maintain all such buildings and other erections that may be found necessary for the accommodation of its members.

To improve and develop generally its property in the interests of the Club.

To sell, pledge, mortgage or otherwise dispose of the property of the Club or any part thereof by the name of "South Branch Fishing Club, Limited", with a capital stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into Fifty Shares of One Hundred Dollars Each. The shares of the Capital Stock of the Club shall not be transferable to any person not then a member of, and shareholder in the Club, until the name of the proposed transferee or member has been first submitted

for the approval of the existing shareholders or members, and approved in such manner as may be prescribed by the by-laws of the Club when incorporated.
