PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916", and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-third day of February, A. D. 1925, incorporating Mary B. Russell, Widow; J. Douglas Russell, Manager; Neil D. Russell, Millman; M. Gertrude Russell, Single Woman; and Frances H. Russell, Single Woman; all of Russellville, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:
