"B. E. SMITH, LIMITED"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act 1916", and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-fourth day of January, A. D. 1925, incorporating Alice Jane Smith, Widow; John Everett Smith, Clerk; and Gretchen Katherine Smith, Spinster; all of the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, take over or otherwise acquire as a going concern from the Estate of Bertram E. Smith late of the City of Moncton, New Brunswick, since deceased, the business heretofore carried on and now by the Estate at the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland, and Province of New Brunswick, with all
