Sewell, doing business under the firm name and style of South Devon Fuel Company, in the County of York and elsewhere in the Province of New Brunswick, and to pay therefore in fully paid-up shares of the Company, and generally to carry on and operate a general fuel supply business in all its branches, and the business of towing, freighting and handling of goods, wares and merchandise.

To carry on the business of logging and lumbering in all its branches, and the buying, selling and dealing in lumber, and lumber products of every kind.

To erect, operate and maintain mills and other plant.

To purchase, acquire hold, own, lease, let, hire and sell, tugboats, steamboats, lighters, freighters, wharves, slips, and all kinds of appliances necessary or conducive to the business of freighters and carriers.

To produce, purchase, deal in, sell and barter either wholesale or retail all kinds of goods, wares and merchandise necessary for carrying on a general merchandising business.

To build, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire own, hold, and possess in fee simple or otherwise, lands, licenses, lumber rights, mills, stores, dwelling houses, warehouses, machine shops, coal yards, sheds, shops, buildings, plant and machinery, scows, barges, wharves, tugs, vessels, marine slips, booms, dams, driving rights, privileges and franchises, and such other real and personal property as may from time to time be acquired or deemed necessary for all or any part of the purposes of, or incident to the business or any part of the same, with power from time to time, to mortgage, pledge, or hypothecate the same or any part hereof, and from time to time to dispose of any or all the property or undertaking of the Company, and with power to amalgamate with any other company having
