November, 1925.

In the matter of the complaint against Sidney H. Hunton and Roy A. Davidson, Barristers of the Supreme Court of the Province of New Brunswick.

On motion of the Honorable J. B. M. Baxter, Attorney General, in support of a motion for a declaration that the said Sidney H. Hunton and Roy A. Davidson have been guilty of acts which render them unworthy of continuing as Attorneys and Barristers of this Court and for an order that they be disbarred and struck off the Roll of Barristers and Attorneys of the said Court and on hearing the resolution of the Council of the Bar of the Province of New Brunswick passed at a regular meeting of the said Council held on Tuesday the 10th day of November, 1925, declaring that the said Sidney H. Hunton and Roy A. Davidson and each of them and why the name of each of them should not be struck off the Roll of Attorneys and Barristers of this Court.
