Grant, Assistant Secretary; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on throughout the Dominion of Canada business as investors, brokers, and agents.

To undertake and carry on and execute all kinds of financial commercial trading industrial and other operations and transactions as an individual may lawfully undertake and carry on, except the business of banking loaning or trust company.

To subscribe for conditionally or unconditionally, to underwrite, issue on commission or otherwise, take, hold, deal in and convert bonds, stocks, shares and securities of all kinds.

To enter into partnership or into any arrangement for sharing profits, union of interest, reciprocal concessions or cooperation with any person, partnership or company.

To promote and aid in promoting, and to constitute, form or organize companies, syndicates or partnerships of all kinds for the purpose of acquiring any property or undertaking of this or any other company, or of any person or persons, firm or copartnership, or for the purpose of undertaking any liabilities of this Company, or of advancing directly or indirectly the objects thereof, or for any other purpose which this Company or the Directors thereof, may think expedient.
