payable under this section to such sum as he may think just, having regard to the nature and importance of its business in New Brunswick and the amount of capi-tal used therein: provided also that with respect to such corporation not carrying on business in New Brunswick heretofore when making return under this Act the Governor-in-Council may reduce the an-nual return fee to such sum as he may think just, having regard to the nature and importance of the business proposed to be carried on in New Brunswick and the amount of capital proposed to be

used therein. A corporation seeking a re-duction of the fee under this section shall give to the Provincial Secretary-Treasur-er such statement and information re-specting its business and financial position as he may call for and shall worth the as he may call for and shall verify the same in such manner as he may require.
