Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Thirty first day of July A. D. 1926, incorporating Walter H. Gray, Merchant; Katherine M. Gray, Married Woman; both of Campbellton, in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick; and E. Lansdowne Belyea, Auditor, of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province aforesaid, for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, take over or otherwise acquire as a going concern and to carry on in all its branches, the Ice Cream manufacturing and wholesale confectionery business and undertaking presently carried on at Campbellton, New Brunswick, under the name and style of Grays Velvet Ice Cream Company, with any part or all real estate and property in connection therewith.

To carry on the business of manufacturing, selling and dealing in ice-cream milk products and confectionery of all kinds and the by-products thereof.

To purchase, sell and otherwise deal in milk, cream, butter or any of the commodities and supplies necessary thereto.

To engage in the business of dairying, butter making and cheese manufacturing and to trade in any of the products thereof.

To carry on generally a wholesale or retail fruit, confectionery, tobacco or ice-cream business and to maintain and operate stores, warehouses, delivery vehicles and depots necessary to the operation thereof.

To carry on any business not contrary to general law which may be incidental or necessary to the main business or any of the objects and purposes of the corporation.

To hold, own, purchase, mortgage, lease, acquire, sell and convey real and personal estate or property necessary or incidental to the purposes of the business.

To issue bonds or other evidence of indebtedness from time to time with or without security or secured wholly or in part by the property of the corporation.

In payment of any property, assets or good-will purchased or acquired by this corporation, the corporation shall have power to issue shares of the capital stock to the amount of the value thereof as fully paid and non-assessable, and to do any and all other things necessary or conducive to any of the objects or purposes of its existence, by the name of "Grays Velvet Ice Cream Co., Limited", with a capital stock of twenty-four thousand dollars divided into two hundred and forty shares of one hundred dollars each, with the head office at Campbellton in the County of Restigouche and Province of New Brunswick.
