"MONTREAL SHIPPING COMPANY (MARITIME), LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under the provisions of "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Second day of November, A. D. 1927, incorporating Cyrus Fluke Inches, Barrister-at-Law; Douglas King Hazen, Barrister-at-Law; and Hilda Lillian Carpenter, Stenographer; all of the City of Saint John; in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on business as steamship owners and ship-builders and as steamship and marine brokers and as insurance adjusters and as agents for marine, fire, life, accident, guarantee or indemnity insurance companies and as custom house brokers and commission agents.

To construct, purchase, hire, exchange, sell, lease, operate, manage and otherwise use, deal with and dispose of any vessels and craft of any kind and their adjuncts and accessories.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and hold any mortgage, pledge or other right and interest of any kind in any vessels and craft of whatever nature.

Generally to carry on business as carriers of passengers, goods and mail by land and water and as warehousemen, for-

warders, stevedores, wharfingers and carters.

To acquire, construct, hire, use, sell, lease and otherwise deal with and dispose of any railway sidings, spurs and branches and tramways and other means of transportation on land owned or controlled by the Company and any wharves, docks, elevators, terminal facilities and other works capable of being used in connection with the Company's business.

To use any of its funds or other assets, or its capital stock to purchase and take over and otherwise acquire and hold shares in any other company having objects similar in whole or in part to those of the Company, for carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as to benefit the Company directly or indirectly, and to invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required in such manner as from time to time may be determined.

To consolidate or amalgamate with any other company having objects similar in whole or in part to those of the Company.

To distribute the whole or any part of the property or assets of the Company in money or otherwise amongst its Shareholders.

To issue and allot and deliver as fully paid up and non-assessable, the shares, debentures or other securities of the Company, or any part thereof, in payment or on its behalf, or in its interest, whether in connection with its promotion and organization or otherwise, or for any securities, rights, things, or other consideration that the Company may acquire, by the name of "Montreal Shipping Company (Maritime), Limited", with a capital stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into Fifty Shares of One Hundred Dollars each with the head office at the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, with permission to hold the Annual Meetings of the Company without the Province and also Special Meetings of the Shareholders and Directors without the Province.
