## Letters Patent Granted

"BOULEAUX FISHING AND GAME CLUB, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that un-

der "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-eighth day of October, A. D. 1927, incorporating John E. Park, Doctor of Medicine; John D. MacMillan, Dentist; LeRoy White, Merchant; and Lester J. Jeffrey, Railway Employee; all of the Town of Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland, in the Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To promote, organize, establish, take over, conduct and manage sporting, country and social fishing and game clubs.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise real estate of any and every description or any interest or right therein, and to take, hold, develop, lease and exchange or otherwise deal in and dispose of the same.

To adopt a constitution and to make by-laws, rules and regulations for the admission, suspension and expulsion of members of any clubs promoted, organized, established, taken over, conducted or managed by the Company, and for the government of such members and for the establishment of different classes of membership, for the assessment and collection of fees and dues, for the election and appointment of directors, officers and committees and the definition of their respective duties and powers, for the safe keeping and protection of the Company's property and funds and generally to hold, regulate, manage, preserve and dispose of the interest and property of all and any such clubs and from time to time to alter, repeal, revise, amend and vary such constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations or any of them.

To provide by by-law that the shares of the capital stock of the Company shall not be transferred to any person until the name of the proposed transferee is submitted to the Directors and they have given consent to such transfer or upon such other terms or conditions as may be provided by such by-law.

To provide by by-law a maximum number of shares of the capital stock of the Company which may be held by any one person.

To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects, by the name of "Bouleaux Fishing and Game Club, Limited", with a capital stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into Fifty Shares of One Hundred Dollars each, with the head office at Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland, and Province of New Brunswick.
