#### SCALER'S LICENSE

In accordance with Section 8 of the New Brunswick Scalers' Act (Chapter 30, 12 Geo. V., 1922) examinations for New Brunswick Scalers' License will be held on Wednesday, September 14th, at the Crown Land Office, Fredericton, beginning at 9 a. m.

"Candidates shall be British subjects, shall be over twenty-two years of age and shall satisfy the examiners that they have had two years' experience in scaling and measuring logs before being permitted to take the examination." (Sub-section C. Sec. 8, Chap. 30.)
