Letters Patent Granted

"WOODSTOCK GOLF CLUB, LIMITED"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act 1916", and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Seventh day of March, A. D. 1927, incorporating William D. Rankine, Medical Doctor; George Mitchell, Printer; George E. Balmain, Collector of Customs; Edgar W. Mair, Merchant; Edgar R. Teed, Broker; Annie T. Connell, Wife of Allison B. Connell, Barrister; and Charles J. Jones, Barrister-at-Law; all of the Town of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton, and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To acquire and take over the whole of the assets, property, privileges, contracts, rights, obligations and liabilities of the Woodstock Golf Club as at present existing, and to pay for the same by the issue and allotment of shares of the capital stock of the Company, fully paid-up and non-assessable, to the members of such Club in good standing at the time of such transfer.

To promote, organize, conduct and manage a golf country and social Club, and to promote the welfare of the members thereof, with power to make and adopt a constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations for the admission, suspension and expulsion of its members, and for their government, and for the establishment of different classes of membership, and for the collection of fees and dues, for the election and appointment of its Directors and other officers, and to define their duties, and for the safekeeping and protection of its property and funds, and in general to regulate, manage and preserve its property and interests and from time to time to alter, repeal, rescind or vary such constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations or any of them.

With power for the Directors from time to time in addition to the powers given them under the provisions of "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916", and amending Acts, to make by-laws, not contrary to law, as follows:

To establish different classes of membership and to regulate the admission of members and requirements of membership, the cessation thereof and the expulsion and suspension therefrom or forfeiture thereof.

To appoint committees to manage the affairs of the corporation, and to pass, adopt and enforce rules and regulations therefor, by the name of "Woodstock Golf Club, Limited", with a capital stock of Ten Thousand Dollars divided into Two Thousand Shares of Five Dollars each, such shares of capital stock shall not be transferable to any person not then being a member of and shareholder in the Company until the name of the proposed transferee has been first submitted for the approval of the existing Shareholders or Members and approved in such manner as may be prescribed by the by-laws of the Company when incorporated, with the head office at the Town of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton and Province of New Brunswick.
