## Letters Patent Granted

### "KWONG YEE TONG, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-ninth day of November A. D. 1927, incorporating Hum See, Laundryman; Hum Sing Yick, Restaurant Proprietor; and Hum One, Laundryman; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John, and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To promote, organize, conduct and manage a Social Club, and to promote the welfare of the members thereof with power to make and adopt a constitution and by-laws, rules and regulations for the admission, suspension and expulsion of its members and for their Government and for the establishment of different classes

of membership, and for the collection of fees and dues, for the election and appointment of its Directors and other Officers, and to define their duties, and for the safe-keeping and protection of its property and funds, and in general to regulate, manage and preserve its property and interest, and from time to time to alter, repeal, rescind or vary such constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations and any of them.

To acquire by purchase, exchange, lease or by any legal title and to own, hold, improve, lease, sub-let, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge or otherwise deal in lands and buildings and also personal property and that of every kind and description.

To guarantee and otherwise assist in the performance of mortgages of persons, firms or corporations with whom the Company may have dealings, and to assume and take over such mortgages and contracts on default.

To draw, accept, endorse, and otherwise execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other negotiable instruments.

To stimulate interest in charitable, philanthropic, religious, social, literary or educational matters in the incorporators and such other persons as shall become members in accordance with the provisions of the Letters Patent or by-laws of the Company.

To promote and foster a spirit of fraternity within the said Club, and to assist the incorporators and other such persons as may become members in accordance with the provisions of the Letters Patent or by-laws of the Company in their undertakings.

The accumulation of Capital by means of monthly subscriptions or otherwise from members and also by borrowing money from members or any other persons on such security and on such terms as may from time to time be arranged.

To advance or lend any of the aforesaid capital or other monies of the Company for the time being on the security of freeholds, leaseholds, bills of exchange, bills of sale, promissory notes, bonds, stock-in-trade, chattels and other property, real or personal, and to realize on such securities.

To acquire any real estate and personal property which the Company may think it desirable to acquire by way of investment or with the view of resale or otherwise and in particular any freeholds, leaseholds, mortgages, shares and securities.

To sell or dispose of the undertakings of the Corporation or any part thereof for such consideration as the Company may think fit.

To do any of the above things as principals, agents, contractors, trustees or otherwise and either alone or in connection with others.
