## Letters Patent Granted

"KWONG YEE TONG, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies" Act, 1916" and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the scal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Hymawick, hearing date the Twenty-ninth day of November A. To guarantee and otherwise assist in the performance of mortgages of persons, frms or corporations with whom the Company may have dealings, and to assume and take over such mortgages and contracts on default.

To draw, accept, endorse, and other-wise execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, and other negotiable Tretrumping.

To stimulate interest in charitable, philanthropic, religious, social, literary or educational matters in the incorporators and such other persons as shall become members in accordance with the provisions of the Letters Patent or bylaws of the Company.

To promote and foster a spirit of fractivity, within the said Coun, and to assertify, within the said Coun, and to assertify.
