WHEREAS it hath pleased Almighty God in His great goodness to vouchsafe this year to Our Dominion of Canada, a bountiful harvest and other blessings. We, therefore, considering that these blessings enjoyed by Our People throughout the Dominion do call for a solemn acknowledgement, have thought fit by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada to appoint, and We do appoint MONDAY the twelfth day of November, 1928, (Armistice Day) as the day of General Thanksgiving to Almighty God for the bountiful harvest and other blessings with which Canada has been favoured this year and We enjoin all Our loving subjects throughout Canada to observe the said day as a day of thanksgiving.

In Testimony Whereof, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. Witness: Our Right Trusty and Well-beloved Cousin Freeman Viscount Willingdon, Knight Grand Commander of Our Most Exalted Order of the Star of India, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order

of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Grand Commander of Our Most Eminent Order of the Indian Empire, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor General and Commander-in-Chief of Our Dominion of Canada.

At Our Government House, in our City of Ottawa, this nineteenth day of September, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight and in the nineteenth year of Our Reign.

## Letters Patent

"E. ALLAN SCHOFIELD, LIMITED"

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927), Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Twenty-second day of October, A. D. 1928, incorporating Ernest Allan Schofield, Merchant; Edith Maud Schofield, Married Woman; and Edward Colpitts Weyman, Barrister;

all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on a financial agency and brokerage business of all descriptions and in particular to act as agents, representatives or managers of any person, firm, association or company incorporated or unincorporated carrying on the business of finance, investment, loan, trust or security company.

To act as trustees, fiduciary, agent or attorney for any company, corporation, person or persons.

To subscribe for, underwrite, buy, or otherwise acquire or to hold and own either as principal or agent or by way of collateral security shares of the capital stock, bonds or other security of any other company or corporation no matter where incorporated and the bonds or debentures of any government, city, town or village and to dispose of such shares, bonds, debentures or other securities and to hypothecate or pledge the same.

To lend money to any corporation or person on mortgage security, promissory note or otherwise.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and hold any real or personal property and to manage, improve, sell, exchange or dispose of or deal with the same.

To purchase or otherwise acquire or undertake all or any part of the business, property, assets or liabilities of any person, partnership or company carrying on business with objects similar in whole or in part to those of the Company or possessed of property suitable and proper for the purposes of the Company.

To let on lease or on hire the whole or any part of the real and personal property of the Company on such terms as the Company shall determine.

To issue, or guarantee the issue of, or the payment of interest on, the shares, debentures, debenture stock or other securities or obligations of any company or association, and to pay or provide for brokerage, commission and underwriting in respect of any such issue.

To take or otherwise acquire and hold shares in any other company, society or undertaking having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the company or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the Company.

To enter into and carry into effect any arrangements for joint working in business, or for sharing of profits, or for amalgamation with any other company, or any partnership or person, carrying on business within the objects of this Company.

To establish, promote and otherwise assist any company or companies for the purpose of furthering any of the objects of the Company.
