That the Directors shall have power to pass a Bye-Law creating and issuing any part of the increased Capital as Preference Shares having a preference of not over 8 per cent as regards dividends, and having priority in case of dissolution or winding up, and with such rights of voting and representation on the Board of Directors as may be decided on by the Directors.
