



WHEREAS, the Legislative Assem bly of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday the 10th day of May, I have thought fit to further prorogue the said Legislative Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued accordingly to Thurs-day the 14th day of June next. Given under my hand and seal at Fred-

ericton the ninth day of May, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight, and in the nineteenth year of His Majes-
