HIS HONOUR THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR has been pleased to approve of the following additional Regulation made by the New Brunswick Liquor Control Board under the provisions of Section 8 of the Intoxicating Liquor Act, 1927:—

Regulation

43. In every case in which liquor is seized by a Police Constable or Officer other than a member of the Provincial Police and in which any claimant to such liquor fails to establish his claim and right thereto under the provisions of The Intoxicating Liquor Act 1927, it shall be the duty of such Police Constable or Officer to deliver forthwith to the Board the liquor so seized.

To acquire by purchase, lease, exchange or otherwise, real and personal property of every nature, kind and description whatsoever and any interests or rights therein, legal or equitable or

otherwise whatsoever, and to take, build, hold, own, maintain and dispose of any such real or personal property and interest therein in any way whatsoever, by the name of "Bay Chaleur Motors Limited" with a capital stock of ten thousand dollars divided into one hundred shares of one hundred dollars each, with the head office at the Town of Bathurst, in the County of Gloucester in the Province of New Brunswick.

Notice is hereby given, that application will be made to the Legislative Assembly of New Brunswick, at its next session, for the passing of an Act, to amend sections two and fifteen of chapter 53 Acts of Assembly 16 George V (1925) entitled, An Act to Incorporate Nepisiquit Storage Company, Limited, by adding to said section two, power and authority to construct, erect and maintain another storage dam at or near Indian Falls on Nepisiquit River with a depth of approximately 150 feet above the bed of the river; and by amending said section fifteen by extending the time provided in that section wherein the construction thereby authorized shall be commenced and completed for a period of two years more than provided for by said section fifteen, and otherwise to amend said act in every manner necessary to completely authorize the construction, maintenance and use of the proposed storage dam at Indian Falls.
