HIS HONOUR THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR has been pleased to order on the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Health and Labor that the following amendments be made in Notifiable and Venereal Diseases regulations:

That immediately after the word "tuberculosis" in Regulation 7 (Notifiable Diseases), the words "Encephalitis Lethargica and Rabies" be added.

That the words "Encephalitis Lethargica" be inserted in Regulation 19 (g) immediately after the words "Typhus Fever".

That the words "suspected to be" be inserted just before the word "infected" in the first line of Regulation 24.

That the word "qualified" be inserted between the words "any" and "practitioner" in Regulation 128 Venereal Diseases, in the first line of the last paragraph thereof.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, sell, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade and deal in or let for hire, automobiles, motor cars, trucks, tractors of all kinds respectively.

To design, manufacture, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire, transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade and deal in aircraft, flying machines and aerial conveyances of all kinds and the component parts thereof and all kinds of motors, machinery and accessories and apparatus for use in connection therewith or in the manufacture, maintenance and working thereof respectively or in the construction and maintenance of any works, inclines or surfaces adapted for use in connection therewith.

To design, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade deal in refrigerators and refrigerating machinery of all kinds including those motivated or run by electricity or gas or otherwise.

To design, manufacture, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade, deal in radio machines and wireless equipment and apparatus of all kinds.
