## Letters Patent

### "ROXIE'S, LIMITED".

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927) Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Thirtieth day of April, A. D. 1929, incorporating, Roscoe Odber Bond, Musician; George Bowman Fisher, Accountant; and Charles Alexander Munro, Merchant; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick, for the following purposes, namely:

To promote the study, practice and knowledge of music and to give or arrange concerts and musical entertainments, and to employ writers and composers, and to purchase copyrights and to give prizes and rewards.

To manufacture, buy, sell, distribute, import, export, exchange, repair and generally deal in all kinds of musical instruments, accessories and supplies, radio machines, radio telephones, wireless equipment and apparatus, electrical machines, appliances, fixtures and parts thereof, all parts of radio machines, radio telephones, wireless telephones, radio accessories and supplies and all apparatus used in the manufacture and installation of radio machines, radio telephones and wireless telephones, and to install and demonstrate radio machines, radio telephones, wireless telephones, radio and wireless systems and radio and wireless equipment.

To construct, acquire, own, operate, manage, deal in, mortgage, lease and otherwise dispose of buildings, works, real estate or personal property, rights or privileges in such manner and upon such terms as the Company may deem fit.

To issue and allot fully paid-up shares of capital stock of the Company given in payment of or in part payment of any property, real or personal, and of any rights and concessions purchased or acquired by the Company or for any services rendered to the Company.

To provide by by-law for such regulations and restrictions on the sale and transfer of the Company's capital stock as the Shareholders and Directors of the Company may from time to time deem advisable.
