ASSEMBLY CHAMBER

FREDERICTON, THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 21, 1929.

This being the day appointed by proclamation for the meeting of the Legislature, at three o'clock His Honour, Major General, The Honourable Hugh H. McLean, K. C., V. D., Lieutenant Governor of the Province of New Brunswick, came to the Assembly Chamber, and being seated on the Throne, was pleased to open the Session with the following:

SPEECH

Mr. Speaker and Gentlemen of the Legislative Assembly:-

Since your last meeting I regret to note the death of Mr. Gordon C. Grant, one of the Members for the County of York, whose kindly nature and unremitting attention to his duties won him many friends.

For a time, you, in common with the whole Empire, were in suspense as to the outcome of the serious illness of His Most Gracious Majesty whose commencing convalescence is hailed with joy and thanksgiving.
