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PROCLAMATION

By His Honour, Major General, The Honourable Hugh H. McLean, K.C., V.D., LL.D., Lieut.-Governor of the Province of New Brunswick.

HIS HONOR THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR has been pleased to order that the following regulation made by the New Brunswick Liquor Control Board and assented to by the Chief Commissioner, May 28th, 1929, be approved:

"46. (1). No person shall sell, either by wholesale or retail, or expose or offer for sale, any rubbing alcohol, unless the bottle or container in which the rubbing alcohol is contained is distinctly labelled with the name of the article, with the word "POISON" in red ink and with the sign of the skull and crossbones.

(2). Every person who violates any provision of this regulation shall be liable to a penalty of not less than Ten Dollars nor more than Fifty Dollars, and in default of immediate payment of the said penalty and costs shall be imprisoned for a period of not less than one month nor more than two months.
