To act as real estate agents, de-velopers, and promoters and in such connection to acquire by purchase, lease, exchange, concession or otherwise any de-scription of real estate and real property, or any interest and rights therein legal or equitable or otherwise howsoever; take, hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, build upon, improve or otherwise deal in and dispose of such real estate and real property or any in-terest therein, to deal with any portion of the lands and property so acquired, sub-dividing the same into building lots, and generally laying same out into lots streets and building sites for residential purposes or otherwise, and with power to construct streets thereon, necessary sewerage and drainage system, and to build upon same for residential purposes or otherwise.

To act as insurance brokers and general agents for employment, and also for the sale and purchase of real estate and all interests therein, and for reward to procure real estate investments for any

To act as managing and or selling agents for the owners of any real estate, of any kind, or any interest therein.

To take over and acquire from any

person or corporation any agency exclu-sive or otherwise for the sale of any sites or interest therein.

Generally to act as real estate, house and rental agents, and as incidental thereto to carry on the business of insurance agents.

To carry on business as financial and investment agents and either as principal or agent to buy, sell and deal in, stocks, bonds, debentures, mortgages on real estate and on personal property, securities, notes and obligations of all kinds, to collect and dispose of interest,

dividends or income upon or from such stock, bonds, debentures, mortgages, securities, notes and other obligations.

To carry on business as contractors, builders, roofers, importers, dealers in and manufacturers of concrete, cement, asphalt, sheet metal, roof preparations and other materials which can be used directly or indirectly by contractors. directly or indirectly by contractors, builders or roofers, with power to act as agents for other persons or corporations

carrying on a similar business.

To carry on any other business of a like nature, or incidental to the foregoing.
