Notice is hereby given that application will be made at the next session of the Legislative Assembly for the passing of an Act amending Chapter 178 of the Revised Statutes of New Brunswick, 1927, section 51 by adding thereto the following:—"The County Council of the Municipality of Queens may at its next annual meeting in January by a resolution change the date of the annual meeting of the Queens Municipal Council from the third Tuesday in January to the last Tuesday in June in each year, and the Semi-annual meeting from the first Tuesday in July to the third Tuesday in January in each year and may pass such resolutions as may be necessary to bring such change into effect", and amending section 12 thereof by adding thereto: "The election of Councillors for the County of Queens shall be held quadrennially on the last Tuesday in October or such other day in October as the County Council may from time to time appoint by bye-law, the first election
