MARITIME THEATRES, LIMITED.

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927), Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the

Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the twenty-sixth day of June, A. D. 1929, incorporating George McClure Willoughby, Barrister-at-Law; Harold Learoyd Steele, Barrister-at-Law; Gerald Murphy, Accountant; Sadie Beatrice Pellett, Stenographer; and Helen Gertrude Dawson, Stenographer; All of the City of Toronto, in the Province of Ontario for the following purposes, namely:

To erect and construct and to operate theatres moving pictures and places of amusement; to carry on the general business of theatre proprietors and managers and to produce and exhibit to the public performances of moving pictures, operas, stage plays, burlesques, vaudevilles, pantomimes, spectacular pieces, concerts and musical and dramatic performances and entertainments; to carry on the business of restaurant keepers, licensed victualers, theatrical agents, dramatic and musical publishers and printers and any other business which may seem calculated to assist any of the Company's powers and rights.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire the whole or any part of the business, property, franchise, goodwill, rights and privileges held or enjoyed by any person or firm, or by any corporation carrying on any business which the company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of the Company and to pay therefor in fully paid-up or partly paid-up shares of the company or in bonds, debentures, or other securities of the company or otherwise, and to undertake the liabilities of any such person, firm or corporation, and to exercise the rights, powers and franchises of any corporation whose capital stock is owned by this company in the name of such company or in its own name.

To manufacture, buy, hire, lease, deal in or otherwise acquire or dispose of or use photographic and other negatives and positives of objects in motion and objects at rest.

To manufacture, buy, hire, lease, sell, deal in or otherwise acquire or dispose of or use any and all materials apparatus, equipment and supplies of every description and processes, patents, trade-marks, trade names, trade rights and rights relating to the production licensing, hiring, leasing, sale and use of photographic and other negatives and positives of objects in motion and objects at rest, whether in connection with or appertaining to the building, hiring, leasing or operation of motion picture theatres or other theatres and places of amusement and instruction of every nature, character and description or otherwise.
