Letters Patent

"EASTERN MOTORS SERVICE, LIMITED".

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927), Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick bearing date the Seventeenth day of November, A. D. 1930, incorporating George Raymond McNutt, Accountant, of Lewisville, in the Parish of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick; Harry Wilson Hickman,

Barrister-at-Law; and Ethel Gertrude Mace, Stenographer; both of the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province aforesaid for the following purposes, namely:

To buy, sell and deal in or with, whether by wholesale or retail, oils, grease, gasoline, benzine, petroleum, derivatives of petroleum and all kinds of petroleum products and by-products thereof.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, maintain, manage and operate garages, gasoline oil and petroleum products stations, storehouses, storerooms, warehouses and other like places for the safe-keeping, cleaning, repairing and care generally of automobiles and motor cars of all and every kind and description and class, and of all accessories thereof and thereto of every and any kind and description, and to lease and hire motor cars, trucks and automobiles of all kinds, to carry and transport passengers and freight in same upon such terms and conditions as the Company may consider advisable.

To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, sell, assign and transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade and deal in or let for hire, automobiles, motor cars, trucks, tractors of all kinds respectively.

To design, manufacture, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire, transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade and deal in aircraft, flying machines and aerial conveyances of all kinds and the component parts thereof, and all kinds of motors, machinery and accessories and apparatus for use in connection therewith or in the manufacture, maintenance and working thereof respectively or in the construction and maintenance of any works, inclines or surfaces adapted for use in connection therewith.

To design, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade, deal in refrigerators and refrigerating machinery of all kinds, including those motivated or run by electricity or gas or otherwise.

To design, manufacture, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, let for hire or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade, deal in radio machines and wireless equipment and apparatus of all kinds.

To engage in, conduct and carry on the business of manufacturing, buying, selling, repairing and dealing in all the aforesaid.

To make, execute and enter into contracts and agreements with any person or persons or with any Company or Companies having objects similar either in whole or in part to those of the proposed Company.

To acquire, by purchase, lease or otherwise, such lands and premises as may from time to time be required for the business of the said Company, and to

sell, mortgage, hypothecate, lease and otherwise deal with the same for any purposes of the Company.

To build, erect, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire any buildings, warehouses or other premises which may be deemed requisite or necessary for any of the purposes of the Company.

To purchase and acquire the goodwill, plant rights and real and personal assets of any person or persons or of any company or companies having powers similar to those of the proposed Company or any of them, and to pay for the same either in whole or in part, in cash or with the stock or bonds of the proposed Company, and to assume and undertake the whole or any part of the liabilities of any such person or Company.

To buy, acquire, transfer, sell and dispose of patent rights, trade-marks and any trade processes, secret or otherwise.

To exercise all or any of the rights or powers aforesaid on its own account or for any other person or corporation and whether as principal or agent or otherwise, howsoever, and to do all such other acts, deeds and things as are incidental to any of the purposes or powers aforesaid or which may be conveniently or with advantage to the Company done in connection therewith.

Generally to do any and all things above set forth as objects, purposes, powers or otherwise and any and all things necessary, suitable, convenient, desirable or proper for the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainment of the objects or the exercise of the powers hereinbefore enumerated or any of them or of any purpose, object or power incidental to any of the same or desirable for the benefit or protection of the Company or any of its properties, to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do by the name of "Eastern Motors Service, Limited," with a capital stock of Twenty-nine Thousand Dollars divided into Two Thousand Nine Hundred Shares of Ten Dollars Each, with the head office at the City of Moncton in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick.
