Letters Patent

"S. B. GAVEL, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of The Revised Statutes 1927), and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick bearing date the Thirteenth day of November, A. D. 1931, incorporating

Stanley B. Gavel, Manufacturer; Laura M. Reilly, Stenographer; and Marion E. Stultz, Stenographer; all of the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick for the following purposes namely:

To carry on the manufacture and distribution of cider, alcoholic cider, aerated and mineral waters and in general all beverages of every kind, nature and description.

To carry on the business of commission agents and importers and exporters of fruits and vegetables of every kind, nature and description.

Generally to purchase, take on lease or in exchange hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property, rights and privileges which the Company may think suitable or convenient.

To erect and construct buildings and works of all kinds for the purpose of its business.

To borrow or raise money for any purpose of the Company and for the purpose of securing the same and interest thereon and for any other purpose to mortgage or charge the undertaking and all or any part of the property or rights of the Company present or acquired including the uncalled capital.

To create, issue, make, draw and accept and negotiate perpetual or redeemable debentures or debenture stock, bonds or other negotiable instruments.

To carry on the trade and business of merchants, commission merchants, exporters and importers of merchandise, of every nature and kind; to act as warehousemen and any other business, or other business subsidiary, auxiliary or similar to any of the business mentioned in this clause and which the Company may deem expedient to carry on in aid thereof or in substitution therefor.

To purchase, hire or otherwise acquire goods, merchandise and personal property of every description, and to sell, barter, let or otherwise dispose of the same.

To carry on the business of merchants by wholesale, retail or otherwise in any or all of its branches with all powers necessary or advantageous for the purpose.

To acquire the whole or any part of the business, property, franchises, privileges, rights and liabilities connected therewith of any person or persons or company or corporation or any business which the Company is authorized to carry on or possessed of property suitable for the purpose of the Company and to pay for the same whether with money, shares fully paid up or otherwise of the Company.

To acquire any exclusive or other rights in letters patent, trademarks, franchises and privileges.

To carry on the business of a storekeeper and in particular to buy, sell, manufacture and deal in goods, stores, tobacco, cigars, consumable articles, chattels and effects of all kinds, both wholesale and retail.

To transact every kind of agency business or transaction which may seem to the Company directly or indirectly conducive to the interest or convenience of the Company.

To buy, sell and deal with by wholesale and retail commodities, articles and things of all kinds which can be conveniently dealt in by the Company in connection with any of its objects.

To purchase or otherwise acquire any business within the objects of the Company and any lands, property franchises, privileges, rights, contracts and liabilities appertaining to the same.

To lend or advance money on interest or otherwise to such parties and under such terms as may seem expedient and in particular to customers and persons having dealings with the Company, and to take any security for such advances or for any indebtedness and to give any guarantee or indemnity that may seem expedient.

To draw, take, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bills of lading, warrants, debentures and other negotiable or transferable instruments.

To raise or borrow money for the purposes of the Company or any of them on such terms, in such manner and in such amounts as the Company shall think fit.

To sell, improve, manage, develop, exchange, lease mortgage, dispose of, turn to account or otherwise deal with, all or any part of the property and rights of the Company.

To carry on the business of buying, selling and dealing in goods and merchandise of all kinds and descriptions, and the business of Commission Merchants.

To act as Broker, and to carry on a general Brokerage business in all goods and merchandise of all kinds and description.

The several clauses contained in the foregoing enumeration of powers shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the statements contained in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or influence from the terms of any other clause but shall be construed as independent purpose and powers, by the name of "S. B. Gavel, Limited," with a capital stock of Thirty Thousand Dollars divided into Three Hundred Shares of One Hundred Dollars each, with Head Office at the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick.
