

articles and any accessories thereof.

To manufacture and deal in wood and rubber of all kinds and to manufacture the same into boxes, barrels, cases and other articles manufactured from wood, pulp and paper.

To purchase, sell, exchange, lease or otherwise acquire real or personal property of all kinds, and in particular, buildings, machinery, plant, stores, patents, licenses, concessions, rights of way, light or water, water or electrical or gas power rights, and any rights or privileges which may seem to the Directors convenient with reference to the business of the Company, and whether for the purposes of re-sale or realization or otherwise, to manage, develop, lease or otherwise deal with the whole or any part of such real or personal property or rights.

To erect all necessary or convenient refineries, mills, works, machinery, laboratories, workshops, dwelling houses for workmen or others, and other buildings, works and appliances and to aid in or subscribe towards or subsidize any such object.

To acquire, construct, maintain, alter, make, charter, lease, hire or work wagons, steamers, ships, docks and canals, bridges, water works, tanks or storage accommodation, reservoirs, wells, aqueducts, roads, streets, hotels, dwelling houses, factories, shops, stores, gas works, electrical power or water works, piers, barges, boats, wharves and other works plant or machinery of every description, and to contribute to the cost of making, providing and carrying on and working the same.

To enter into contracts or arrangements with any Government, Municipal or other body, corporation, company or person as to interchange of traffic, running powers, joint working or otherwise which may seem expedient.

To carry on for the purposes of the Company, business as storekeepers, carriers, shipowners, electrical, gas and other engineers, builders or contractors and any other business which may seem directly or indirectly conducive to the development of any property, in which the Company is interested, or to the benefit of the Company.

To acquire by grant, purchase or otherwise, concessions of any property or privileges from any Government, or from any authority, supreme, municipal, local or otherwise, and to perform and fulfil the terms and conditions thereof.

To obtain or assist in obtaining any provisional or other order or license, permit, franchise or other authority for enabling the Company to carry any of its objectives into effect, including charters or laws conferring any jurisdiction.

To remunerate any person or company for services rendered in placing or assisting to place or guaranteeing the placing of any of the shares in the Company's capital, or any debentures or other securities of the Company, or in or about the formation or promotion of the Company or the conduct of its business.

To buy, sell, manufacture, repair, alter and exchange, let or hire, export and deal in all kinds of articles and things which may be required for the purposes of any of the said businesses or commonly supplied or dealt in by persons engaged in any such businesses or which may seem capable of being profitably dealt with in connection with any of the said businesses.

To purchase, or otherwise acquire and register or otherwise record any patents, trade marks, brevets d'invention, licenses, concessions and the like conferring any exclusive or non-exclusive or limited right to use any secret or other information as to any invention which may seem to the Company capable of being profitably dealt with; to use, exercise, develop and grant licenses in respect of or otherwise turn to account any such patents, trade marks, brevets d'invention, licenses, concessions and the like, and with a view to the working and development of the same to carry on any businesses, whether manufacturing or otherwise which the Company may think calculated directly or indirectly to effectuate these objects.

To offer for public subscription, establish or promote or concur in establishing or promoting any other company, corporation, association or private undertaking for the purpose of acquiring all or any of the property, rights and liabilities, of this Company, or for any other purpose which may seem directly or indirectly calculated to benefit this Company, and to acquire and hold shares, stock or securities issued by or any other obligation of any such company, corporation, association or undertaking, and to defray all or any of the expenses of the establishment or promotion of any such company or corporation, association or undertaking as aforesaid, and to subsidize or otherwise assist any such company, corporation, association or undertaking, and to guarantee or underwrite subscriptions or to subscribe for the same, or any part thereof, or to employ others to underwrite or subscribe therefor.

To advance or lend money, securities or assets of all kinds to customers and others having dealings with the company, and to any other company having objects similar in whole or in part to those of this Company upon such terms as may be arranged and either with or without security.

To invest and deal with the moneys of the Company not immediately required, and in such manner as from time to time be determined.

To draw, accept, endorse, negotiate or deal with bills of exchange, promissory notes, letters of credit, circular notes or other negotiable or mercantile instruments.

To adopt such means of making known the products of the Company as may seem expedient, and in particular by advertising in the press, by circulars, posters, street cars, busses or any other method, or by purchase and exhibition of works of art or interest, by publication of books and periodicals, and by granting prizes, awards and donations.

To enter into partnership or into any arrangement for sharing profits, union of interests, co-operation, joint adventure, reciprocal concession or otherwise, with any person or company carrying on or engaged in, or about to carry on or engage in, any business or transaction which this Company is authorized to carry on or engage in, or any business or transaction capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit this Company, and to lend money to, guarantee the contracts of, or otherwise assist any such person or company, and to take otherwise acquire shares and securities of any such company, and to sell, hold, re-issue, with or without guarantee, or otherwise deal with the same.

To sell the undertaking of the Company, or any part thereof for such consideration as the Company may think fit, and in particular for a consideration consisting in whole or in part of cash or shares or debentures of any other Company.

To procure the Company to be constituted or registered in any foreign country as may be found expedient.

To distribute in specie, by way of dividend or otherwise, among the members, customers or employees of the Company, or otherwise, any shares or securities belonging to the Company, or any property or assets of the Company applicable as profits of the Company, and to make any arrangements considered advisable with its employees as to profit sharing.

To subscribe to any fund, corporation or institution, incorporated or not incorporated, and to act by delegate or otherwise upon any trade, council, committee, chamber of commerce, syndicate or other body of persons formed to lawfully promote either the general interests of businesses to which that of the Company is allied, or in which the Company is interested or any other business that may be deemed conducive to the interests of the Company.

To establish and support or aid in the establishment or support of associations, institutions, funds, trusts and conveniences, calculated to benefit employees or ex-employees of the Company or its predecessors in business, or the depend-

ents or connections of such persons, and to grant pensions, and allowances, and to make payments towards insurance and to subscribe or guarantee money for charitable or benevolent objects, or for any exhibition or for any public, general or useful objects.

To purchase, lease or acquire water or other power and to generate electrical or other power and to use, lease, sell or otherwise dispose of the same.

To amalgamate with any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to those of this Company.

To do all or any of the above things and as principals, attorneys, contractors or agents or otherwise and either alone or in conjunction with others or by or through the agency of others.

To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

And it is hereby declared that in these presents the word "Company" (except where used in reference to this Company) shall be deemed to include any partnership or body of persons, whether corporate or incorporate.

And it is hereby further declared that the objects specified in each paragraph of these presents shall be in no wise limited by reference to any other paragraph, but may be extended thereby.

The several clauses contained in the foregoing enumeration of powers shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or influence from the terms of any other clause but shall be construed as independent purposes and powers, by the name of "Brown-Holder Biscuits, Limited", with a capital stock of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars divided into Three Thousand Shares of One Hundred Dollars Each, with the head office at the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland, and Province of New Brunswick.
