**"JOHN M. ROBINSON & CO., LIMITED"**

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of The Revised Statutes 1927), and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Second day of October, A.D. 1931, incorporating, John Morris Robinson, Broker; Beverley Robinson Armstrong, Barrister-at-Law; both of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint

John and Province of New Brunswick; and John Coles Belyea, Barrister-at-Law; of Rothesay, in the County of Kings and Province aforesaid, for the following purposes, namely:

To purchase, receive, hold, sell, own or otherwise deal in bonds, mortgages on real estate or personal property, debentures, notes, shares of capital stock and other securities, obligations, contracts, evidence of indebtedness of any private, public or municipal corporation or company, or of the Government of the Dominion of Canada, or of any Province or Territory thereof, or of any foreign State or Country.

To act as agent for others in the custody, investment, loan, payment and collection of money and securities, the transfer and recording of bonds, debentures, shares or other securities, the promotion of companies and undertakings, the sale of property and the collection and receipt of moneys.

To conduct the general business of a holding investment, promoting and brokerage Company and real estate agency.
