By His Honour, Major General, The Honourable Hugh Havelock McLean, K.C., V.D., LL.D., Lieut-Governor of the Province of New Brunswick.

HUGH HAVELOCK McLEAN,
Whereas the Legislative Assembly of this Province, convened on Thursday, the Twelfth day of February, last, and continued its Sitting until this day, being the Twenty-Sixth Day of March instant, I have thought fit to prorogue the said Legislative Assembly, and the same is hereby prorogued accordingly to Thursday the Fourth day of May next.

Given under my hand and seal at Fredericton, the Twenty-second day of April, in the year of our Lord one Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-One, and in the Twenty-First Year of His Majesty's Reign.

Letters Patent

"A. S. BOWMAN COMPANY, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927), and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary.

Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the Fourth day of May, A. D. 1931, incorporating, Arthur Simon Bowman, Mercantile Broker; George Schofield Beer, Mercantile Broker; Annie Ethel Bowman, Married Woman; and Frances Grace Beer, Married Woman; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To carry on business as grocery brokers, manufacturers agents and commission agents.

To buy, sell and otherwise deal in goods, wares and merchandise of all kinds and descriptions, whatsoever.

To carry on a general brokerage, exporting and importing business.

To carry on a general mercantile business as importers and dealers in all kinds of goods, wares and merchandise, whether wholesale or retail, and by means of stores, warehouses, shops or agencies in all such places as the Company may deem profitable and advantageous.

To act as commission and commercial agents in respect of all kinds of natural, imported or manufactured products of every nature and description, and to buy and sell all such products upon a commission, salary or other lawful consideration.

To purchase, sell, manufacture, handle on commission and otherwise deal in cheese, butter, flour, hog products, grain and generally all classes of farm products, factory supplies and all manufactured articles.

To conduct a general warehousing and storage business, and in connection therewith to engage and deal with warehouse receipts, make and obtain advances thereon, and generally to do all things which may be necessary or incidental to any of the foregoing classes of business.

To buy, sell, manufacture, import and export, and generally deal in all kinds of canned, preserved, pickles and cured fruits and vegetables, grains, provisions, meats, fish, fowl and game, and extracts, syrups, jams, marmalades, essences, sauces, relishes, jellies, cider and cider vinegar, aerated and evaporated fruits, products of the field, farm and forest.

To purchase, sell and otherwise deal in all kinds of merchandise which may be required by bakers or confectioners and generally to purchase, sell or otherwise dispose of goods, wares and merchandise of all kinds and descriptions.

To buy, sell, import, export and deal in cocoa, chocolate, confectionery and confectionery supplies in all forms and processes of manufacture.

To export, import, manufacture, buy, sell and deal in goods, wares and merchandise without limiting the generality of the foregoing; the same shall be deemed to include confectionery, biscuits, candy and all goods in which sugar or flour forms a part; and to act as agents, brokers and commission merchants for the

purchase or sale of any such goods, wares or merchandise.

To buy, sell and otherwise deal in condensed, preserved and evaporated milk and all forms of manufactured milk and all the products of milk and all food products.

To buy, sell and otherwise deal in all garden, farm and dairy products, and to do any and all things connected with or incidental to the carrying on of such business or any branch or part thereof.

To carry on business as transfer and transportation agents.

To charter steamships in whole or in part or to make such arrangements for transportation purposes as the Company may find advantageous or expedient for the purposes of its business.

To act as general warehousemen and forwarding agents.

To do a general customs brokerage business.

To purchase, lease, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property, and in particular any land, buildings, easements, machinery, stock-in-trade, etc.

To acquire and take over any other business or businesses having similar objects in whole or in part to those of the said Company.

To issue as fully paid-up stock shares of the Capital Stock of the Company in consideration for property, real and personal, acquired by the Company and in payment for services rendered in the promotion and formation of the Company.

To do all such things as are incidental and conducive to the attainment of the above objects, or any of them by the name of "A. S. Bowman Company, Limited."

To amalgamate with any other company or companies having similar objects to those of the proposed Company.

To take shares and securities in other companies and promote other companies' undertakings or for any other purpose and similar to those of the proposed Company, by the name of "A. S. Bowman Company, Limited," with a capital stock of Ten Thousand Dollars divided into One Hundred Shares of One Hundred Dollars Each, with the Head Office at the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick.
