Upon incorporation of Companies having a stated capital, or amendments increasing capital, an additional fee equal to the fee payable under the N.B. Joint Stock Companies' Act.

A page for the purposes of this Rule, shall mean not exceeding 500 words.

Provided, that when a Bill in respect of which such payment has been made, does not pass the Legislature, it may be introduced at the next following Session upon the payment of an additional sum of \$10.00.

(BARACHOIS FISHERMEN'S ASSOCIATION, LIMITED).

To carry on business as a grower, shipper, exporter, importer and dealer in seeds, farm, garden and dairy produce, and all other food products, and in connection with the business of the Company to establish stores, agencies, depots and other markets for the sale of the products of the Company.

To carry on the business of warehousemen, including the operation of cold storage warehouses or plants.

To manufacture and deal in cans, boxes, jars, containers, labels and canners' supplies.
