THE MIRAMICHI FISH PROTECTIVE ASSOCIATION INCORPORATED, LIMITED

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 83 of The Revised Statutes 1927), and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick, bearing date the First day of August, A.D. 1931, incorporating, George Whalen, Fisherman; Hedleigh McCloskey, Fisherman; William Griffin, Fisherman; all of the Village of Boies-town, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick; Jack Russell, Fisherman, of the Village of Ludlow, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick; J. LeRoy Betts, Fisherman; Charles R. Hutchison, Fisherman; Randolph Crocker, Accountant; all of the Village of Millerton, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick; William B. Jones, Manager; and R. Traven D. Altken, Barrister; both of the Town of Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To secure the perpetuation of the Mira-

Michi River and its tributaries as fishing waters.

To encourage and promote the propagation both by natural and artificial means of the fish in these waters, and, upon their invitation, to support the public authorities in the proper development of fishing as an industry.

To secure a strict and impartial enforcement of the fish and game laws and to provide a medium of mutual co-operation whereby action or proceedings may be taken as may be necessary to protect fish and game or otherwise in the interests of its members individually or collectively.

To pass a by-law limiting the voting power of the stock holders of the said Company to one vote each regardless of the amount of stock held by the voter.

With the consent of the Government of the Dominion of Canada, whenever such consent may be applied for and given, to employ and pay guardians or watchmen to assist the government guardians in watching and protecting the said River and its tributaries against poachers or illegal fishing of any kind whatsoever.

To do any and all such things ancillary to the powers hereinbefore specifically mentioned as are specified and enumerated in Section 14 of "The New Brunswick Companies' Act," being Chapter 83 of The Revised Statutes of New Brunswick, 1927, by the name of "The Miramichi Fish Protective Association Incorporated, Limited," with a capital stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into Five Thousand Shares of One Dollar Each, with the Head Office at the Town of Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland and Province of New Brunswick.
