### "MARSHLAND MOTORS, LIMITED"

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of the Revised Statutes 1927), Letters Patent have been issued under the seal of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick bearing date the Twenty-third day of February, A. D. 1931, incorporating Kenneth J. MacRae, Barrister-at-Law; Lesley L. Pickett, Barrister-at-Law; and Sam Richey, Manager; all of the City of Saint John, in the County of the City and County of Saint John and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes, namely:

To establish automobile garages in the City of Moncton and elsewhere in the Province of New Brunswick, and to maintain, run or manage the same.

To buy, sell, own, exchange, let for hire and deal in all kinds of automobiles, motors, autocycles, airplanes, motor engines, automobile supplies, fittings, furnishings, oil, gases or gasoline and other power producers used in connection with automobiles, motors, motor boats, airplanes and other like modes of conveyance.

To acquire, own and hold real and personal property that may be deemed useful in connection with the business of the Company, and to dispose of, mortgage and pledge the same.

To act as agents for manufacturers, persons and corporations who may employ the proposed Company as its agent in the sale and manufacture.

Generally deal in goods mentioned in the above first clause, and to do such other things as are incidental thereto.

To maintain and operate automobiles

and to carry therein for hire, from place to place, freight, goods and passengers, subject to the provisions of the "Motor Carrier Act".

To do all such other acts and things as are incident or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them and to carry on any business whether manufacturing or otherwise germane to the purposes and objects set forth and which may seem to the Company capable of being conveniently carried on by the Company or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of its properties or rights.

To amalgamate with any other company, or companies having similar objects to those of the proposed company, to take shares and securities in other companies, and to promote other companies to acquire the Company's undertaking or for any purpose calculated to benefit the Company, by the name of "Marshland Motors, Limited", with a capital stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into Fifty Shares of One Hundred Dollars Each, with the head office at the City of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland and Province of New Brunswick.
