To lend or invest money upon security or otherwise and to carry on a loan and investment business in all its branches.

To act either as principal or agent in all kinds of financing, trading and other operations.

To carry on the business of insurance agents and brokers in all its branches.

To maintain and conduct a general collection agency and business.

To manage and administer estates and to act as trustee agent or otherwise in any trust or appointment for the transaction of any business, subject to any Act or Acts in relation thereto.

To promote, finance or reorganize any company, undertaking or enterprise.

To pay the costs of and incidental to the promotion, incorporation and organization of the Company.

To purchase or acquire shares in any other company having objects altogether or in part similar to those of the Company or carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as directly or indirectly to benefit the Company.

To have, possess, exercise and enjoy all the rights, powers and privileges vested in companies by "The New Brunswick Companies' Act" (being Chapter 88 of The Revised Statutes 1927) and amendments thereof, and to do all things authorized thereby, by the name of "Montrose, Limited", with a Capital Stock consisting of Five Hundred Shares without Nominal or Par Value which may be issued and allotted for such consideration as may be fixed by the Board of Directors but shall not exceed in value the sum of Ten Dollars Per Share, with the Head Office at the City of Fredericton in the County of York and Province of New Brunswick.
