To purchase, take over or otherwise acquire as a going concern the whole, or part of the business now carried on at the City of Moncton in the Province of New Brunswick by Philip H. Fryers and Robert B. Cowan known as "The DeLuxe Oil Company" and all or any of the assets and liabilities of the proprietors of that business in connection therewith, the undertaking and good-will thereof and all the rights and contracts now held by the proprietor subject to the obligations, if any, affecting the same, and to pay for same in shares of this Company and by cash.

To carry on business, both wholesale and retail, in importing, exporting, buying, selling and refining oils, grease, gasoline, benzine, petroleum, derivatives of petroleum and all products of a similar nature including by-products, and operate service stations for the sale of same.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, maintain, manage and operate warehouses, garages, stations, storehouses and other like places for the safe keeping, cleaning and repairing of automobiles and motor vehicles of every kind, class and description and of all accessories thereto.

To design, manufacture, acquire, hold, own, sell, assign, hire and let for hire, transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade in and repair aircraft, flying machines and aerial conveyances of all kinds, and the component parts and accessories thereto.

To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire, hold, own, sell and repair motors and motor engines of every description, and accessories thereto.

To design, assign, hold, own, sell, hire, let for hire, repair, transfer or otherwise dispose of, invest, trade and deal in refrigerators, refrigerating machinery of all kinds, radios, radio machines, wireless equipment and all accessories thereto.

To acquire, purchase, own, sell, exchange, lease, mortgage, hypothecate and dispose of real and personal property in connection with the business of the said Company, by the name of "The DeLuxe Oil Company Limited" with a Capital Stock of One Hundred preferred shares of the par value of One Hundred Dollars each, subject to the preferences, restrictions and conditions hereinafter set out, and Two Thousand Common Shares without nominal or par value, which said shares without nominal or par value may be issued for such consideration as the directors may from time to time determine, not exceeding, however, the sum of Four Dollars and Ninety-five cents per share.
