

"THE INDEPENDENT FISHERIES LIMITED."

Public Notice is hereby given that under "The New Brunswick Companies Act" (being Chapter 88 of The Revised Statutes 1927) and amending Acts, Letters Patent have been issued under the Seal of the Provincial Secretary Treasurer of the Province of New Brunswick bearing date the Fifteenth day of August, A. D. 1932, incorporating William Edgar Kiscadden, Fisherman; Perry Marshall Small, Fisherman; both of the Village of Woodward's Cove, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick; and John Dalzell, Fisherman, of the Village of Castalia, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick; for the following purposes:

To operate, manage, conduct, handle, carry on and engage in the business of buying, selling, packing, salting, curing, canning, smoking, preserving and marketing all kinds of fish, smoked fish and other sea, lake or river foods and also for the manufacture of fish or bone meal.

To acquire, purchase, build, lease, construct, maintain and operate smoking, packing, salting, curing, canning, storage buildings, houses and sheds.

To construct own, acquire or lease wharves, docks, warehouses, fish plants, smoking sheds and other buildings and facilities and land and premises in connection therewith.

To acquire build, own, hire and operate, navigate, sell and charter fishing boats, freight boats, ships, tugs, vessels, motor boats, and other boats and equipment necessary and incidental to the fishing industry.

To purchase, sell, handle on commission and otherwise deal in smoked fish and fish and sea food products of all kinds.

To buy, manufacture, sell, handle and deal in boxes, cases and containers of all kinds for the storing, packing and shipping of fish.

To engage in and carry on a general wholesale and retail business in fish, and to establish, operate and conduct agencies, plants, stores, depots and branches for the sale of all goods and merchandise dealt in by the Company in any and all places which may seem fit to the Company.

To buy, sell and deal in salt and salt products, oils, gasolines, greases, and fishing gear, clothing supplies and equipment of every kind used in connection with the fishing industry.

To carry on any other business which may seem to the Company capable of being carried on conveniently in connection with its business, directly or indirectly to enhance the value or render profitable any of the Companies rights.

To purchase, take on, lease or exchange, hire or acquire any Real Estate, or personal property, or any rights which to the Company may seem fit and necessary for the purpose of its business.

To buy, sell, acquire, hold and transfer shares of any other Company or Corporation or interest in any partnership carrying on a business similar to that of the Company.

That the Company shall possess as incidental and ancillary to the powers hereinbefore enumerated all powers specified and enumerated by Section 14 of "The New Brunswick Companies Act" being Chapter 88 of The Revised Statutes of New Brunswick 1927.

To do any and all things above set forth as objects, purposes, powers or otherwise, and any and all things necessary, or incidental thereto, for the accomplishment of the purposes or the attainments of the objects, or the exercise of the powers hereinbefore enumerated, or any of them, as well without the Province of New Brunswick as within, to the same extent, and as fully as natural persons might do by the name of "The Independent Fisheries Limited" and to have all and any other rights, powers and privileges incidental to a body corporate under the New Brunswick Companies Act 1916, and amending Acts thereto, with a Capital Stock of Five Thousand Dollars divided into shares of Two Dollars each, with the Head Office at the Village of Woodward's Cove, in the County of Charlotte and Province of New Brunswick.
