**THE JUDICATURE ACT**  
**Amendments re Summons for Directions,**  
**and Examination for Discovery.**

**In re SUMMONS FOR DIRECTIONS**

**ORDER 14.**

Rule 8 is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

"8. Where leave, whether conditional or unconditional, is given to defend, the Judge shall have power to give all directions as to further conduct of the action and may order the action to be forthwith set down for trial."

**ORDER 20.**

Sub-section (b) of Rule 1 is repealed and the following substituted in lieu thereof.

"(b) Subject to the provisions of Order 18A, in all other cases the plaintiff shall deliver a statement of claim within ten days after appearance."

Sub-section (c) is repealed.

**ORDER 21.**

Rule 6 is hereby amended by striking out the words "or a summons for directions" at the end thereof.

Rule 8 is repealed and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

"8. When a statement of claim is delivered or when filed in default of appearance under Order 13, Rule 10, the defendant, unless otherwise ordered, shall deliver his defence within ten days from the delivery, or filing in default of appearance, of the statement of claim unless in either case the time is extended by a Court or a Judge."
