That the scales of fees provided in subsections (1) and (5) of section 11 and section 12 of The Theatre Act be repealed and the following substituted in the following substituted in

11. (1) Every person attending a performance at a theatre and every person attending any place of amusement or participating in any amusement, as mentioned in clause (h) of Section 2 shall upon each admission or attendance or participation where a fee is charged for the same pay to His Majesty for the use of the Province a tax as herein provided and according to the following scale:—
Where the admission fee is not more than Twenty-five Cents, a tax of . .02
Where the fee is more than Twenty-five Cents and not more than Thirty-five Cents, a tax of . .04
Where the fee is more than Thirtyfive Cents and not more than Forty Cents, a tax of . .05
Where the fee is over Forty Cents a tax of One Cent additional for each Ten Cents or fraction thereof in excess of Forty Cents.

1.
