That the regulations respecting the incorporation of companies by Letters Patent under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, be amended as follows:

1. The Honourable the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer is hereby designated as the Officer charged with the issue of Letters Patent and Supplementary Let-

Letters Patent and Supplementary Letters Patent; and the Department of the Honourable the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer as the Department through which such issue shall take place.

2. The signatures of the subscribers to the Petition for Letters Patent or Spplementary Letters Patent, or to the Memorandum of Association, shall be verified by affidavit to the satisfaction of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer.

On Supplementary Letters, when appli-cation is to increase the Capital Stock, the fee shall be payable upon the in-creased amount for which Letters are applied for, according to the aforegoing

In all other cases a fee of \$60.00.

All fees must be paid in cash or by an accepted cheque, payable to the order of the Provincial Secretary-Treasurer or Deputy Provincial Secretary-Treasurer, and must be transmitted by Registered Letter.

The fees to be charged upon the in-corporation of companies by Letters Pat-ent under the New Brunswick Companies' Act, Section 17 for charitable, philanthropic, temperance, religious, social, politi-cal, literary, educational or other like purposes, where there is no capital stock and where the cost value of the real and personal property specified under Section 17, shall be as follows:
