No non-resident will be permitted to guide fishermen in the New Brunswick waters of the International waters between New Brunswick and the United States unless he has taken out a New Brunswick Fishing Guide's License, which may be obtained from the Department of Lands and Mines for the annual fee of \$22.00; and any non-resident who guides fishermen in the waters referred to without a New Brunswick Fishing Guide's License and any non-resident sportsman who employs as a fishing guide in the waters referred to a non-resident who is not a registered New Brunswick Fishing Guide shall be guilty of an offence against the New Brunswick Fisheries Act and liable to the penalty provided for violation of Regulations made under Sections 13 and 26 of the said Act.
