MILITIA GENERAL ORDERS.

Frederickton, 29th May, 1832.

THE Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief has been pleased to order the following arrangement to be observed for the General Inspection of the Militia the present year; and his Excellency expects Commanding Officers to be particularly exact in their returns and prepared to deliver to the Inspecting Field Officer before his leaving the Field, a General State of their respective Battalions.

Quarter-Masters are also required to furnish the Inspecting Field Officer with an account of the Contingent funds of their Regiments, up to the end of last year; and Captains of Companies will likewise be called upon to account for the Non-attendance of such persons as were reported absent at the last General Inspection, and for the fines of Delinquents.

JANUARY TERM, 1832.

IT IS ORDERED, that the Scale of rates and fares to be taken by Carmen, Waggoners and Truckmen in the Town of Frederickton, as established at the General Sessions holden on the second Tuesday in June 1825 be repealed, and that in lieu thereof the following rates and fares not greater shall be demanded or taken for the services therein set forth in that part of the Parish of Frederickton, which lies between the Government House westward, the College and Alms House eastward, and the first Creek of Gully between the Town of Frederickton southward, (including the said Government House, College and Alms House); under the penalty of ten shillings for each and every offence, to be recovered and applied as the Act directs.
