Hatheway, praying remuneration for their time and expenses in attending at the Bar of the House, pursuant to the Speaker's Warrant, as witnesses touching a question of the Breach of the Privileges of the House, submitted the following report, which he read

"That the committee on searching the Journals of the House of Commons, find it is the practice to order remuneration to be made to witnesses who have attended at the Bar of the House, pursuant to the Speaker's Warrant, to be paid by the party or individual at whose instance such witness may be called: that in the present instance the witnesses having attended pursuant to the directions of the House, touching a matter relating to the privileges thereof, your committee are of opinion, that the Petitioners should be allowed their reasonable expenses to be ascertained by Mr. Speaker, and to be included in the Bill for the contingent expenses of the present Session.
