**A PROCLAMATION.**

IN pursuance of the Powers vested in me by  
An Act of Parliament, passed in the Sixth  
year of the Reign of His late Majesty King  
George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to re-  
gulate the Trade of the British Possessions  
abroad," I have thought fit, by and with the  
advice and consent of His Majesty's Council,  
to appoint, and I do hereby, by and with the  
advice and consent aforesaid, appoint the Town  
of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton,  
a place of Entry for the Entry of Goods brought  
or imported from any adjoining Foreign Coun-  
try, pursuant to the provisions of the said Act,  
of which all persons concerned will take due  
notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

Fredericton, the twenty-third day  
of February, in the year of our  
Lord One thousand eight hundred  
and thirty-three, and in the third  
year of His Majesty's Reign.
