Applications for Licences to cut Timber will be extended to Five Year Berths, if made before the 1st October next, and if not then applied for, Petitions for Five Years occupation will be received and complied with, subject only to the Timber then under license, as no increase or extension of licence will be permitted to those persons who do not avail themselves of the privilege of securing the ground for Five Years, agreeably to the existing regulations.

UNDER the authority of His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, the Public Sale of CROWN LANDS, at the Crown Land Office on MONDAY the 5th of October next, will comprise:—

6,000 acres in Scully's Survey on Eel River, being the second and third Tiers from the Res-tigouche, County of Gloucester.

1,000 acres in Davidson's Survey of Lots on the Tatigouche and its vicinity, in said County.

15,000 acres, being surveyed Lots, on the Road from Bathurst to Tabusintack, in said County.

Several vacant Town and Pasture Lots in the Town Plat of Dalhousie, in said County.
