The Latter Convicted. The York county court, Judge Steadman presiding, opened at 10.30 a.m. Tuesday.

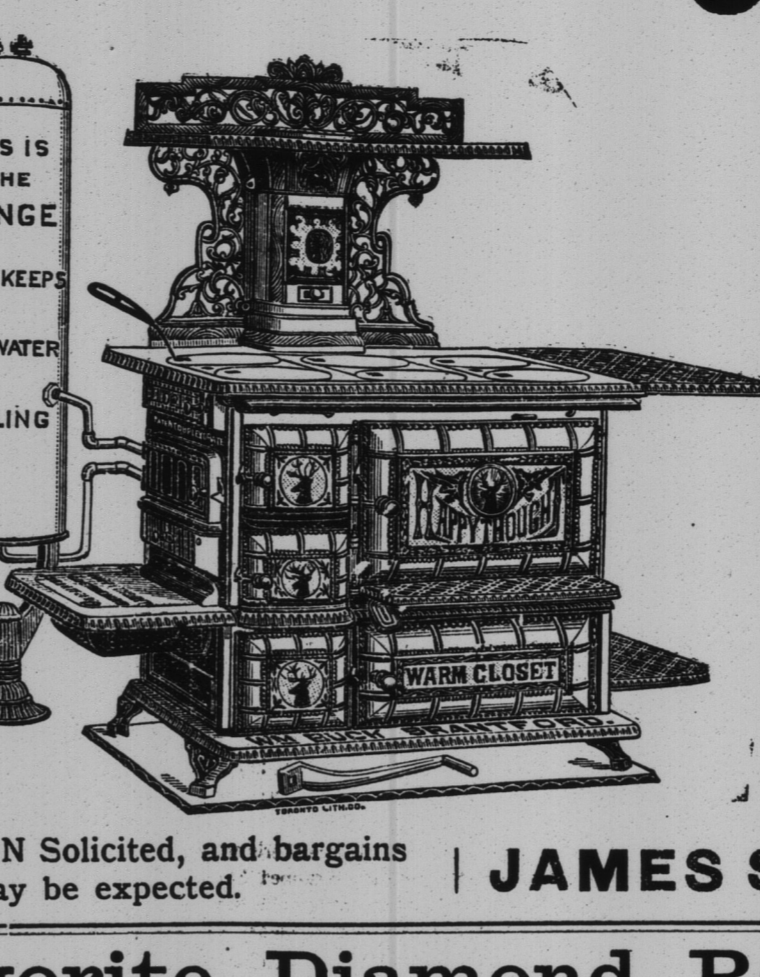

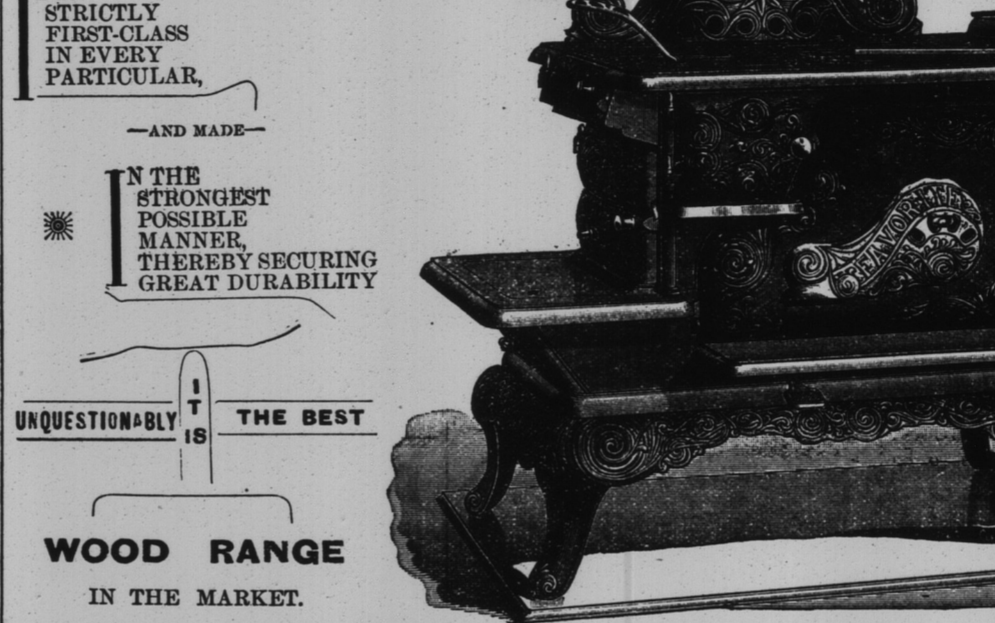
