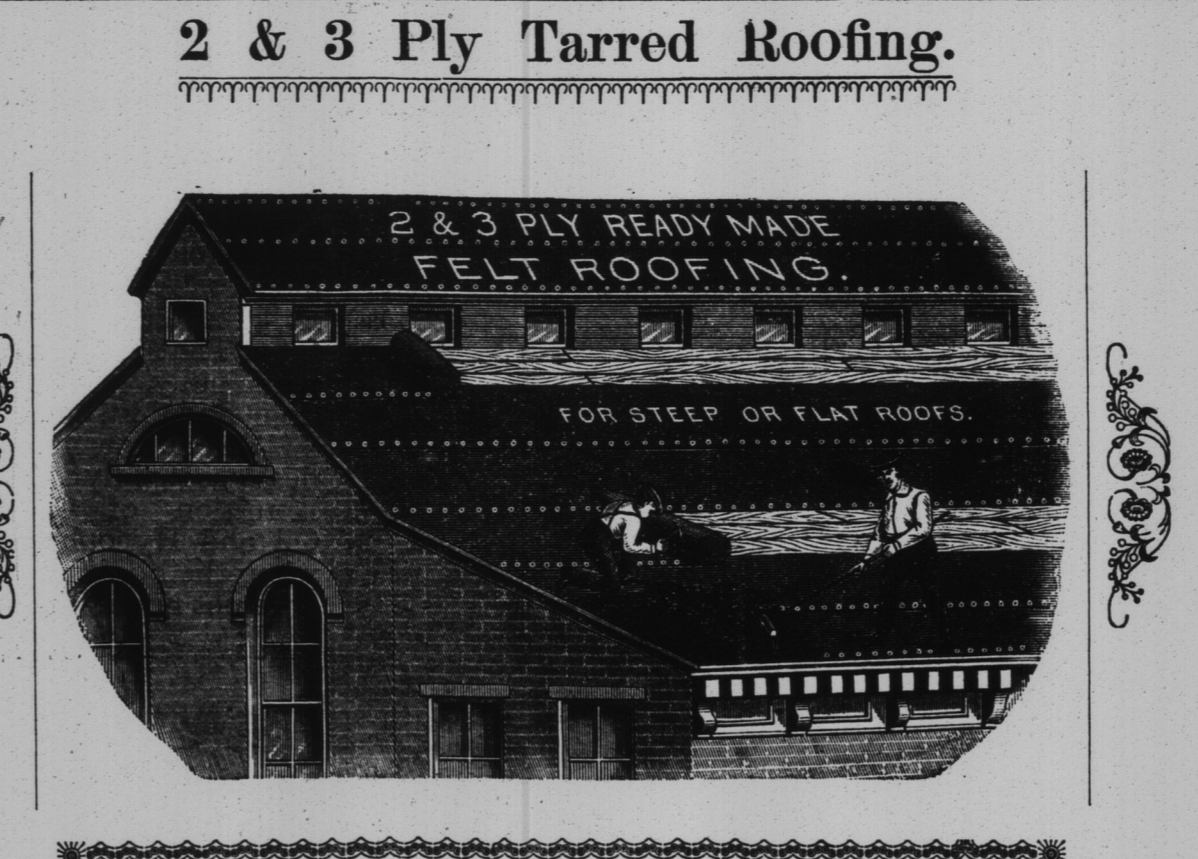
Social, Personal and General Occurrences of the Week.
