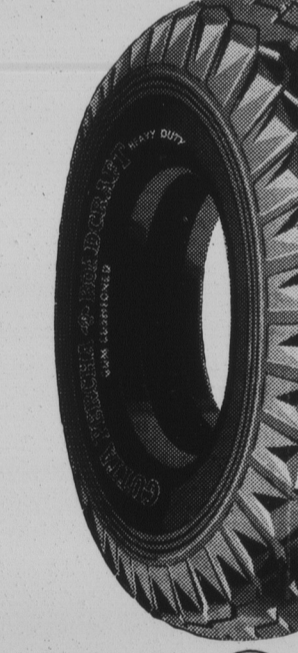

PORK LEADS IN MEAT CONSUMPTION

Montreal, Que., June - If one were to ask what was the favorite meat of Canadians they may possibly be hard put to answer the question but it would seem that pork occupies first place. In 1932 Canadians consumed 81.79 pounds per capita and the consumption is increasing jumping from 72.93 in 1930 to 83.49 in 1932, according to the Agricultural Department of the Canadian National Railways. The total consumed for the year 1932 was 964,385,673 pounds.

OPENING FOR MARITIME EXPORTS IN PALESTINE

Montreal, Que., June - When A. Chaboussier came out of Ur the Chaldees to found a new nation, he found a land of 10,500 square miles much of which is rocky and desert land about half the size of the province of Nova Scotia and today, has a population of over one million, according to the Natural Resources Department of the Canadian National Railways. The census of 1931 shows the population consists of 759,712 Moslems, 174,810 Jews, 91,298 Christians, 10,101 Hindus, 90,500, about the size of Calgary, Alta., Jaffa (61,866), Haifa (50,403), about the size of Regina, Sask., (Hilifax, in Nova Scotia, has 52,278); and Tel Aviv (46,101), similar in size to Saint John, N. B. Other important centres are Hebron (17,241), Nabulus (17,189), Gaza (17,041), Lydda (12,230), Ramle (10,421). Percentage of rural population as against urban is 65. The main business of Palestine is agriculture although there are several manufacturing establishments. Due to the recent expansion there has been a considerable import of building materials. The principal export is citrus fruit, particularly oranges and grapefruit. Export of manufactures includes soap, wine, sunflower oil, cement, olive oil, weaving apparatus, artificial teeth, stockings, beads and mother-of-pearl, cattle feed cake, stationery, bluettes, cakes and Passover bread, leather handbags, fruit juice and syrup, chesses, bedsteads, mirrors, chandeliers and confectionery, paper and cardboard goods, cotton yarn and thread and cotton manufactures. The United Kingdom was the greatest exporter in 1932 with a percentage of 19.88. Egypt follows with 15%, Syria 10.47%, Germany 9.98%, British possessions.
